No more than two for funding eligible partners from Austria participating in the call will be accepted within one consortium! Please note that Austrian participants cannot participate in a consortium under the widening option at the full proposal stage.

Researchers are eligible to apply if their publication record over the last five years has been internationally visible and if their current career stage is commensurate with the career progression expected in their field. (see <u>1.4.1 General requirements</u>)

The current FWF salary scale (<u>Personnel costs (fwf.ac.at</u>)) indicates the salaries that may be requested. For scientists funded by the FWF, the funding is limited to "project-specific costs", i.e. personnel and non-personnel costs that are essential to carry out the project and that go beyond the resources made available from the research institution's infrastructure, according to the general FWF Funding Guidelines published at <u>Application guidelines Principal Investigator Project</u> (<u>PROFI mode</u>) (fwf.ac.at)

The FWF does not finance infrastructure or basic equipment at research institutions. Overheads may not be requested. Subcontracts must be well justified, i.e. must represent the only or the most economical way to have the work performed, please contact the FWF directly for clarification of individual cases.

### FWF Submission:

In addition to the application to the call secretariat, **pre-proposals** must be submitted online to the FWF at <u>https://elane.fwf.ac.at</u> via the programme category "PIK – International Projects" (preproposal)". The deadline for submission is 16th of January 2025, 2 pm CET (local time in Vienna)

For the full-proposal stage, applicants must choose the programme category "KIN – International – Multilateral Initiatives" The deadline for full-proposal submission is 10th of July 2025, 2 pm CEST (local time in Vienna)

### Both steps are mandatory.

All proposals must be submitted using the elane online portal. Project funding is administered through the research institution (PROFI); for this reason, the submission must be approved in the application portal both by the applicant and by the respective research institution.

Please note that the number of ongoing/approved projects in which one researcher can serve as principal investigator is limited to three in the Stand-Alone Projects Programme, International Programmes, Clinical Research and Arts-Based Research Programmes. ### **Other Funding Criteria**

### !! IMPORTANT !!

- o Applicants for FWO funding must submit a mandatory administrative application via the <u>FWO E-loket</u>.
  - For fundamental research projects (FO) select the application type: 'Research projects European programme fundamental research'.

- For strategic basis research projects (SBO) select the application type: 'Research projects – European programme strategic basic research'.

In case the consortium includes more than one partner requesting funding from FWO, a <u>single online</u> <u>form</u> should be submitted by the main PI (promotor(-spokesperson)) itself, through its personal 'e-loket', containing all relevant information for the different Flemish partners.

The deadline to submit this administrative application to the FWO is identical to the deadline of the joint transnational call (pre-proposal stage). To ensure the eligibility of the proposal, it is recommended to

consult the FWO administration at least one week in advance. <u>Failure to comply with these</u> requirements can lead to ineligibility.

- Participation in this call does not interfere with the 'regular/national' project submission framework, and is consequently not taken into account for calculating the max. available number of new applications and running projects combined. However, researchers can only participate within 2 different international consortia in this call as partner.
- Projects aiming at the development of a spin-off company are not eligible in this context.
- The project duration is limited to 36 months, which implies the funding has to be budgeted and spent accordingly. An automatic prolongation and using positive (financial) balances after the end date is not applicable in this framework. As such article 28 of the <u>FWO Research Projects</u> and article 14 of the <u>Strategic Basic Research (SBO)</u> regulations do not apply here.
- The PI, for each of the participating institutions applying for FWO funds, must hold an **appointment** that fully covers the duration of the research project.

Linked to the above, when it comes to the <u>FWO research project regulations (FO)</u>: article 10, §7 is not applicable in this call. I.e. supervisors (-spokespersons), or coordinators/consortium partners in this context, who are granted **emeritus status** during the calendar year of submission of the project application or during the duration of the project execution, are **not eligible**.

- Walloon partners in the consortium must include at least one company, and the research budget of the Walloon partner companies must account for at least 40% of the total research budget of all Walloon partners.
- Participants must be based in Wallonia, and the Walloon companies must have an operational unit in Wallonia.
- Participants cannot receive any other public funding for the same activities.
- Participants must have fulfilled their obligations under any previous support granted by the Region.
- At the time of submission, companies must not be in difficulty according to the European Union guidelines.
- Projects must focus solely on civilian technologies, products, processes, and services.
- Participants must present an innovative R&D project that has a positive impact on the Walloon economy and aligns with the priority of the regional Smart Specialization Strategy (S3 Wallonia).
- Participants must demonstrate their ability to carry out the tasks assigned to them in the project, to exploit its results, and to have a positive socio-economic and sustainable development impact on Wallonia.
- The project cannot start at a TRL (Technology Readiness Level) lower than 3.



Those who submit an application are considered to be informed about this requirement of reporting and are considered to approve that this reporting will be made above the legal thresholds.

In addition to support according to GBER, we can provide support according to the government's regulation on support of minor importance (EU 2023/2831). This type of support is also called de minimis support (2 § 2 p. / EU Regulation nr 1407/2013).

Universities, research institutes and non-profit legal entities as well as public bodies may receive funding of up to 100 % of their eligible costs, provided that the project is part of their non-economic activities.

## **Eligible Costs**

Our funding may only go to certain types of costs. These are called eligible costs. In this call for proposals these types of costs are eligible:

- Personnel costs: Salaries, social security contributions and other personnel costs
- Equipment, land and buildings: Instruments, equipment and rent for premises other than regular business premises
- Consulting and licensing costs: Consulting services, knowledge and patents purchased or used under license from an external actor. Consultancy costs should not exceed 10-20% of a project part's budget
- Other direct costs: For example materials, stock items and travel necessary to carry out the project
- Indirect costs (overhead, OH): Costs that are not incurred as an immediate consequence of but can be related to the project, for example regular premises and cleaning. Universities and colleges may budget for indirect costs according to their usual full cost principle. For other organisations, indirect costs may constitute a maximum of 30 percent of personnel costs, unless special rules apply, as is the case for instance for state-funded research insitutes or organisations. It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that the correct level for indirect costs is applied in the application.

For more detailed information on which costs we can finance, see the instruction on eligible costs below.

For a cost to be eligible, it must be necessary for the activities of the project. Project costs must also be properly accounted for and reported separately from the organisation's other costs. An organisation may also not take up someone else's costs as its own. For more detailed information on which eligibility requirements, limitations and exceptions apply, see the instruction on eligible costs.

## Additional guidance

Swedish applicants may be contacted by the Swedish Funders after the pre-proposal has been sent in and asked to provide information on their application in the national application portal.

After the transnational evaluation process each successful application with Swedish participants will be assigned to one administrating Swedish Funder, either Formas or Vinnova.

Successful Swedish applicants will be contacted by their designated Swedish Funder and asked to provide a Swedish application in their application portal.

If two or more Swedish partners participate in the same application one of them will act as the Swedish coordinator in relation to the Swedish Funder (even if the international project is not coordinated by a Swedish organisation). The national application shall for example entail a short project description, a description of the Swedish contribution and budget specifications for Swedish applicants. ## Who may apply?

An application for funding from NWO has a single (main) applicant, with the possibility of coapplicants within the same application for NWO funding.

Researchers may submit an application if they have a tenured position (and therefore a paid position for an indefinite period) or a tenure track agreement at one of the following research organisations:

- universities as referred to in Article 1.8 paragraph 1 of the Higher Education and Scientific Research Act (WHW) and universities listed in the Policy Rules for Universities located in the Kingdom of the Netherlands;

- university medical centres by which is meant academic hospitals as referred to in Article 1.13 paragraph 1 of the WHW;

- institutes affiliated to the Royal Netherlands Academy of Arts and Sciences (KNAW) or NWO;

- the Max Planck Institute for Psycholinguistics in Nijmegen;
- Naturalis Biodiversity Center;
- Advanced Research Centre for NanoLithography (ARCNL);
- Princess Máxima Center.

Persons with a zero-hour employment agreement or with a contract for a limited period of time (other than a tenure track appointment) may not submit a proposal.

It could be the case that a tenure track agreement ends before the intended completion date of the project for which funding is applied for, or that before that date, the applicant's tenured contract ends due to a researcher the applicant reaching retirement age. In that case, the researcher applicant needs to include a statement from their employer in which the organisation concerned guarantees that the project and all project members for whom funding has been requested will receive adequate supervision for the full duration of the project. Such as statement should be submitted in the full proposal stage.

Applicants with a part-time contract should guarantee adequate supervision of the project and all project members for whom funding is requested.

Furthermore, researchers may be interested to apply as a co-applicant within an application for NWO funding. Co-applicants within an application for NWO funding may be affiliated to the research organisations listed above, to universities of applied sciences, and to other research organisations as referred to in Article 1.1, paragraph 4 of the NWO Grant Rules which meet the following cumulative conditions.

The organisation must:

- be established in the Netherlands;

- be a foundation, association or legal entity governed by public law;

- have as its primary goal the independent conduct of its own fundamental research, industrial research or experimental development;

- be able to state that the organisation keeps separate accounts with regard to economic/noneconomic activities and that undertakings with decisive influence on the organisation do not enjoy preferential access to the organisation's results.

## Personnel

Other partners (than UAS), like SMEs, public authorities and/or NGO's may be funded within the project as consortium partners. Maximum funding percentage for these partners is 50% of their costs.

## Students

Students may work on the project. If the students contribute as part of their curriculum, the rate applies according to the usual internship fee of the UAS. If students contribute as a side job in addition to their studies as student assistants, the rate according to HOT Table 2 scale 1 applies.

## **Material Costs**

Funding can be requested for all costs for the project and its knock-on effects regarding, among other things, consumables, purchase of services, materials, small instruments, access to (inter)national facilities, software and resources that have no economic value after use. Travel and accommodation costs (national and international) for all people working on the project including foreign guest researchers, costs for the organization of (international) workshops and symposia, costs for data management, publications, and costs in the context of *citizen science* also fall under this module.

Travel expenses (national and international) will only be reimbursed on the basis of second class/economy class fares. For publications, the provisions in the <u>Beleidsregel Open Access</u> apply.

It is not allowed to include costs for:

- regular educational activities.
